I was 3/4 across and an oncoming car forced me into the last column on bridge. It damaged the door where it would not close and lock. We tied it to the inside and headed to Texas. Went to Nacogdoches, Texas on Tuesday and let them look at it. Went to revival in Haltom City then Monday following headed back to Nacogdoches. Progressive Insurance adjuster came. Discovered that I had a major problem on coach that no one had ever mentioned to me. The bulkhead had separated 1 1/2 inches. We were in danger and did not know it. God had protected us each mile. If it had totally broken the holding tanks would have dropped onto pavement along with the axle. God is good to the Burkhalters.. We praise Him for His mercy on us. This problem was totally separate from the door incident. The door incident was a blessing for we found out the danger we were in. Plus, Progressive gave us a very generous estimate of \$14, 500 with \$1,000 deductible. God has put us in connection with the right people. The adjuster was the son of a Baptist pastor. The man doing the work told me up front he was a born again believer. We still believe this was the RV God had for us and He has taken care of us and provided majority of finances to repair problem. Gary the repair man just called me and said things were progressing and said it would probably be 3 more weeks before it would be ready. When we left it there last Friday, we loaded essentials in a U-haul trailer and headed to Missouri. Went through rain, freezing rain and snow. We have much to thank the Lord for.

Donna and I have thanked and praised the Lord many times recently for His protection on us. We have traveled from Florida to Pennsylvania, to western

Nebraska and western Oklahoma. We have always prayed when traveling that God would give us protection. He certainly answered many prayers for many miles.

As 2018 winds down, we are grateful for God's goodness to us this year. God has been faithful. He has blessed us spiritually, physically and always somehow made a way financially. He made a way for us to purchase the motorhome. I am thankful that God called me to be an "evangelist." We praise God for every life that has been touched through this ministry. By faith we plan to continue to walk through the doors God opens and proclaim the glorious Gospel.

We ask you to pray for us to have safe travels and to be freshly anointed as we minister in song and the preached Word in each service. Revival, Renewal is needed and we believe it can still happen.
